## Enrollment Requirements

**ALL forms must be completed to enroll your child in school.**

1. **PROOF OF AGE VERIFICATION** – Must be a certified copy of birth certificate, baptismal certificate or passport  
(Required for Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> grade only) Your child must reach the age of five (5) on or before December 2 of the current school year (EC48000a) to be admitted to kindergarten.

2. **RESIDENCY VERIFICATION**  
Please review form for acceptable verification.

3. **IMMUNIZATION RECORDS** – Must be official record from medical doctor/clinic  
The following immunizations are required by law for admission to public school.

Polio (4 doses)	3 doses if at least 1 dose was given on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday
DPT (5 doses)	4 doses if at least 1 dose was given on or after the 4 <sup>th</sup> birthday
Hepatitis B (3 doses)	
MMR (2 doses)	2 doses after age 1 or 4 days before 1 <sup>st</sup> birthday.
Varicella (1 dose)	or doctor verification that child has had the disease.

4. **STUDENT ADMISSION FORM**  
Complete **both sides** of this form. A signature is required at the bottom.

5. **EMERGENCY CARD**  
Complete **both sides** of this form. These are your instructions to us in case of illness or accident. We will only release your child to adults listed on this card who show proper identification. Be sure to include numbers that are different from your home. If there are any changes in work locations or who may or may not pick up your child, contact the school office immediately. This card is treated as confidential and is restricted to authorized personnel only.

8. **ORAL HEALTH ASSESSMENT/WAIVER REQUEST FORM**  
California law (EC 49452.8) requires that your child have an oral health assessment their first year of public school. This form must be returned to the Health Office by April 30.

9. **FIRST GRADE PHYSICAL FORM** – Must be signed by a medical professional  
State law requires that all 1<sup>st</sup> grade students have a physical exam when entering 1<sup>st</sup> grade. This exam may be done up to 18-months before entry to 1<sup>st</sup> grade and must be submitted to the Health Office by December 1<sup>st</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> grade year. Many children have this exam prior to the start of Kindergarten. However, in order to stay within the 18-month requirement, this exam cannot be done any earlier than the first Wednesday in March.
