

EMPLOYEE USE OF DISTRICT ISSUED MOBILE TECHNOLOGY DEVICES

The Monrovia Unified School District Board of Education recognizes that technology devices (such as laptops, tablets, computers, cellphones and other computing/communication devices) can enhance employee performance by improving communication and facilitating district and school operations. All designated employees shall be assigned the necessary mobile devices and services to communicate by radio, telephone or other electronic medium, and perform their duties as appropriate.

The District's technology devices must be used primarily for district business. Incidental personal use of non-cellphone devices is allowed, but must be in accordance with BP 4040. Violations of district policy related to assigned technology device(s) use are subject to discipline up to and including termination.
