

HUMAN SEXUALITY—LESSON 6

KINDERGARTEN

In this unit the theme is commitment. We talked about the love and loyalty we feel towards our family and friends. We reviewed ways that we can be helpful, caring people.

GRADE 1

In this lesson, we discussed trusting those who always show us their love, especially our families. We also discussed trust and faithfulness of friendships.

GRADE 2

In this lesson the children are helped to recognize that God is always faithful in His promise to love us. We learn from Him that we must be loyal to our families and friends. The children are encouraged to be faithful—to share themselves, to forgive and to ask forgiveness, to keep in touch with friends who move.

GRADE 3

To help children appreciate these concepts concerning faithfulness. Friends keep promises. Jesus trusted God, and God kept His word. Acting unfaithfully has unhappy results.

GRADE 4

The aim of this lesson is to emphasize the concept of faithfulness in these ways: To love myself is to be faithful to who I am and who I can become. I can become the faithful friend that I would like to have. Faithfulness is important to all relationships, especially the marriage relationship.
Sensitive vocabulary: Review of purity, modesty, chastity. Introduce prudence, temperance, fortitude, and justice.

GRADE 5

This lesson is aimed at developing an appreciation of the role dedication and loyalty play in personal development and in responsible relationships. It lays the foundation for understanding the kind of commitment that is necessary in all walks of life, vocations, and careers.

GRADE 6

Mature Christian sexuality, in whatever state of life, demands life-enriching commitment to other persons and the community. In this lesson, we will discuss God's loyalty to us and our loyalty to others. We will also talk about the difference between being a member of a group and a clique, which is particularly important at this age. Discussion questions will be coming home with your child.
