

ADULT EDUCATION

The Governing Board recognizes that education is a lifelong process and that it is important for individuals to continuously develop new skills.

OPTION 1: The Superintendent or designee shall develop and oversee the district's adult education program. The Board shall approve all courses to be offered in this program.

OPTION 2: The district may participate in the adult education program administered by the county office of education. Students enrolled in this program shall be under the immediate supervision of a certificated district employee.
