

The Constitution
of the
Presidents Clubs of Calvary Chapel High School

Preamble

We the students of Calvary Chapel High School, consistent with all legal guidelines, do hereby establish this constitution to provide the best means of executing school business and representing student opinions.

Article I

Name:

The Name of this Organization shall be "Presidents Club."

Article II

Purpose:

The purpose of the Presidents Club shall be (a) to coordinate with all CCHS Clubs; (b) to provide CCHS with an organized and simple school year; (c) to foster constructive communication and interaction between the members and the administration and faculty.

Article III

Membership:

- Elected Presidents of a Club at CCHS

Article IV

Parliamentary Authority

The rules contained in "Robert's Rules of Order Revised" shall govern the proceedings of all organizations of the Presidents Club unless inconsistent with the stipulations of the Constitution, Bylaws, or Handbooks of CCHS.

Article V

Presidents Club Lifestyle Agreement

Section 1. The grounds for a mandatory six weeks' leave of absence from Presidents Club shall be a failure to maintain a 3.0 GPA throughout the officer's term of service.

Section 2. The grounds for absolute dismissal from Presidents Club shall be an officer's suspension from CCHS, expulsion from CCHS, or aggregation of 25 points during the officer's term of service.

Article VI

Executive Duties and Functions of the Presidents Club

Section 1. The Duties of the Presidents Club is to organize the events, meeting times, and activities of the Clubs at CCHS.

Section 2. The Members of Presidents Club are as followed ASB President, NHS President, Key Club President, Scrabble Club President, Choir Club President, NAHS President, Pink Ribbon Club President, Christian Club President, Spirit Lead art President, and Newspaper Editor. Of these members the ASB President presides over them.

Section 3. ASB reserves the right to schedule the date of your event but not the nature of the event.

Section 4. The Presidents Club shall take action at meetings scheduled regularly by the ASB President, or at special meetings called by the ASB President or a petition of four members of the Presidents Club. A quorum of four members shall be required for formal action.

Article VII

Members of the Presidents Club

Section 1. The ASB President presides over the Presidents Club. He/She manages the order and schedules of meetings and all other events put on by the clubs.

Section 2. The members of the Clubs are Presidents of a CCHS authorized, student run Club.

Article VII

Elections

Section 1. The Election of a President comes from the Clubs own Constitution.
