

**CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE**

In accordance with the Political Reform Act (Government Code Section 81000, et seq.) and the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) Regulation 18730 (2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 28730), the Monrovia Unified School District adopts and promulgates the Conflict of Interest Codes as presented in 2 Cal. Code of Regs. 18730.

An accompanying administrative regulation shall include the Conflict of Interest Code, the persons/positions required to file and the categories for which each must report.

## **EXHIBIT "A"**

### **CATEGORY 1**

Persons in this category shall disclose all interest in real property within the jurisdiction. Real property shall be deemed to be within the jurisdiction if the property or any part of it is located within or not more than two miles outside the boundaries of the jurisdiction or within two miles of any land owned or used by the agency.

Persons are not required to disclose property used primarily as their residence or for personal recreational purposes.

### **CATEGORY 2**

Persons in this category shall disclose all investments and business positions.

### **CATEGORY 3**

Person in this category shall disclose all income and business positions.

### **CATEGORY 4**

Persons in this category shall disclose all business positions, investments in, or income (including gifts and loans) received from business entities that manufacture, provide or sell service and/or supplies of a type utilized by the agency and associated with the job assignment of designated positions assigned to this disclose category.

### **CATEGORY 5**

Persons in this category shall disclose all income from any district employee, any representative or association of any such employee and business positions or income from any entity owned or controlled by such employee or his/her spouse or other financial dependent.

### **CATEGORY 6**

Individuals who perform under contract the duties of any designated position shall be required to file Statements of Economic Interests disclosing reportable interest in the categories assigned to that designated position.

\* “Consultant” shall include any natural person who provides, under contract, information, advice, recommendation or counsel to a state or local government agency. This person shall file Statement of Economic Interest Form 730 and file with the Board of Supervisors.
