- 1.6% of students are served in English to Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL)
- 25% of students are served in Early Intervention Program (EIP)
- 20% of students are served in Remedial Education Program (REP)

Additional Programs

- Career, Technical and Agricultural Education (CTAE) - 1,068 students
- Advanced Placement (AP) - 370 students are enrolled in at least one of 11 different AP courses offered
- International Baccalaureate Programme (IB) - 232 students enrolled in pre-IB or IB classes
- AVID (Advancement Via Individual Determination) - 66 students enrolled from 9th and 10th grades

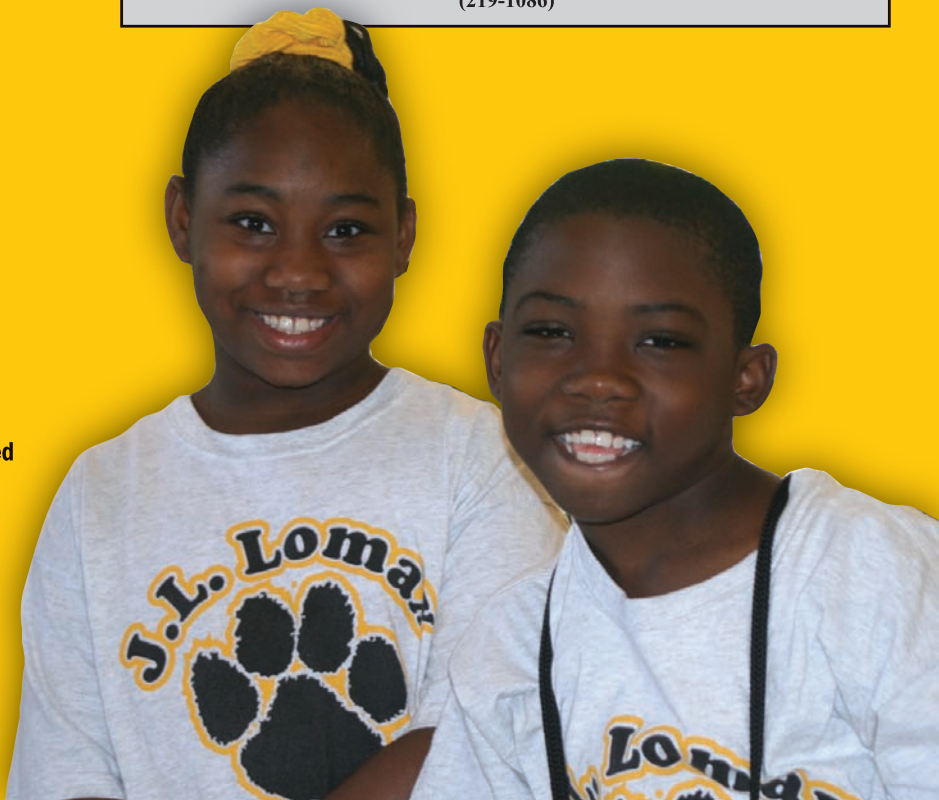
