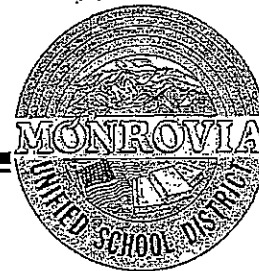

This Independent Study master agreement is in effect for the Spring term of the 2007/08 school year. The term of this agreement shall be more than five days. Independent Study is a voluntary optional educational alternative in which no pupil may be required to participate; a classroom option is always available. In the case of a suspended expulsion student, pursuant to Ed Code 48915 or 48917, an alternative of classroom instruction has been offered and is available at all times. All resources and services of this school are also available to the student. At the end of the semester an evaluation will be held to determine placement for next semester.
