The Board of Education welcomes visitors to school and district sites and to school activities and events, on and off campus. The Board of Education is also committed to providing safe, orderly, positive environments and experiences, free from disruption, for all students, staff and visitors.

The Board of Education expects all school district employees to be courteous, respectful, and helpful when welcoming visitors. Furthermore, the Board promotes, expects, and supports mutually courteous, respectful, and civil conduct in all interactions among school staff, students, and the public; encourages open, positive, and cooperative communication; and will not tolerate volatile, abusive, hostile, aggressive, and threatening actions or language.

This policy is not intended to deprive any person of his/her right to freedom of expression, but it is intended to maintain a safe civil, respectful environment for staff, students, and visitors. The district seeks public cooperation with this endeavor.
