

# **HUMAN SEXUALITY—LESSON 3**

## **KINDERGARTEN**

In the lesson loved and loving, we will come to understand that families, as well as people, are unique and different. We experience God through being loved in a family.

## **GRADE 1**

The theme of the third lesson is "loved and loving". The principle is to further the children's appreciation of all people: male and female, rich and poor, black, yellow, red, and white, who are all loved by God. The lesson will emphasize Jesus' request to love others by what we say and do.

## **GRADE 2**

This lesson teaches the children that Jesus was loved by His Father and He loves us. They learn that each person is created to be loved and to love. They realize that all people are worthy of love.

## **GRADE 3**

How people's differences are all an important part of God's plan. Read I Wish I Were A Butterfly. Relate the story to people and the changes that take place when we grow up. The students will do activity writing their responses under the words FEELINGS - BODY - MIND. Under their responses they will complete sentences. Think and discuss what the children think Jesus would have been like when he was their age and how he changed as he grew up. Read the Scripture and discuss. Reflect on lesson. Pray.

## **GRADE 4**

The aim of this lesson is to assist children in realizing that 1) Love is at the root of order and law. 2) We must have respect for the rights and dignity of others. 3) Families, friends, and married people express love through words, actions, gestures, and objects.

## **GRADE 5**

The aim of the lesson this week is to help the student gain a deeper understanding of the nature of love, especially as it relates to friendship. The two central themes are: the distinction between fairness (justice) and generosity (love), and the fact that friendship, like love is a gift; it cannot be forced on another or forced from another. Again, an activity will be sent home for you to complete with your child.

## **GRADE 6**

The aim of this lesson is to help students form a clearer understanding of the different dimensions of human love. Each dimension has an effect on each person. Also, each person is created to be loved and to love, as Christ, loved by the Father, loves us. Discussion questions will be sent home to conclude this lesson.
