

POLITICAL ADVOCACY

To support and guide its advocacy efforts, the Governing Board may establish a plan of action periodically during the year, or to address timely issues. Such plans may include:

- Adoption of advocacy messages
- Adoption of resolutions
- Identification of specific advocacy actions and timelines, such as;
 - letters
 - meetings with legislative representatives
 - quarterly communications regarding advocacy messages
 - speaking engagements before designated civic organizations
 - press release to news media
 - invitations to legislative representatives to a Board meeting to present current legislative issues
