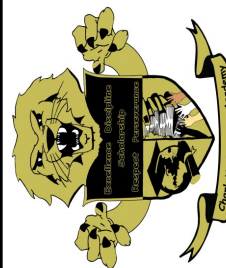
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
