

GOVERNING BOARD ELECTIONS

Any person is eligible to be a Governing Board member, without further qualifications, if he/she is 18 years of age or older, a citizen of the state, a resident of the school district, a registered voter and not legally disqualified from holding civil office.

A district employee elected to the Board shall resign his/her position before being sworn in or shall have his/her employment automatically terminated upon being sworn into office.

Statement of Qualifications

A candidate for a regular trustee election in the Monrovia Unified School District will be obliged to pay all charges for a State of Qualifications to be mailed with the sample ballot, in accordance with the Election Code and consistent with procedures as adopted by Los Angeles County, December 27, 1966. Such charges shall be paid by candidates at the time Statements of Qualifications are filed. Statements shall be limited to 200 words.

The district shall assume no part of the cost of printing, handling, translating or mailing candidate statements filed pursuant to Elections Code 13307.

The Board secretary shall notify the county clerk of this policy on or before the 125th day before each Board member election.

Tie Votes in Board Member Elections

Whenever a tie makes it impossible to determine which of two or more candidates has been elected to the Board, the Board shall immediately notify the candidates who received the tie votes of the time and place where lots shall be cast to determine the winner.
