Appearing on the transcript of the graduating senior, the Seal of Biliteracy is a statement of accomplishment for future employers and for college admissions.

Requirements if
primary language is
English

1. Complete all ELA
requirements with a GPA
of 2.0 or higher.

2. Pass the 11th grade
CST in ELA at the
Proficient Level

3. Show Proficiency in one or
more languages, other than English,
using **ONE** of the following
methods:

Pass a foreign language
Advanced Placement (AP) exam
with a score of 3 or higher.

Complete a 4-year high school
course of study in a foreign
language with a GPA of 3.0

Pass the SAT II foreign
language exam with a score
of 600 or higher

Requirements if primary
language is NOT English

Achieve Early Advanced
Proficiency Level on the
CELDT

Complete requirements
1-3 for primary English
Language students
