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Community

Hemet Unified School District encompasses one incorporated city and numerous unincorporated communities within its 700+ topographically diverse square miles. We have 29 elementary and secondary schools with an enrollment of over 23,000 students. Agriculture still provides an important economic influence, as do other light and service industries. The rural flavor of the community still survives despite the rapid growth which has taken place in the area. Hemet High School has garnered a reputation for quality programs in Advanced Placement, fine arts, athletics, general academic program, drop-out prevention and agriculture. Hemet High School was awarded the honor of California Distinguished School in 2009.

School

Description – Four year comprehensive high school.

Enrollment – 2526 (senior class 635; junior class 592; sophomore class 641; ninth grade class 658)

Faculty – 98 certificated staff members. More than half of Hemet High School’s certificated staff hold advanced degrees, and more than 60% of our staff participate in continuing education activities.
