

The following is the method that is used to determine if an athlete is eligible to participate in a sport: (7th and 8th graders only)

- The student must be passing five (5) classes for the week to be able to play/participate in the game(s) the following week.
- The teacher will put a check by the students name in box “A” or “B” every Friday during the season on an electronic file found in the staff folder.
- The “A” box is checked if the student is doing unsatisfactory work academically and the “B” box is checked if the student is receiving an unsatisfactory citizenship mark.

It should be noted that grades and behavior are weekly and are not cumulative.

A student will be declared **ineligible** to participate in any athletic contest (game or scrimmage) for one week if any of the following occur:

- A student receives two “A”s (unsatisfactory academically) in his/her academic classes
- A student receives two “B”s (unsatisfactory behavior) in citizenship
- A student receives an “A” or a “B” in any class two consecutive weeks
- The following are the consequences:

First Occurrence: student placed on probation...”study sessions” may be required

Second Occurrence: student is ineligible to participate in games until the next eligibility check

Third Occurrence: student is ineligible to participate in games and meets with coach/parent/AD and/ or principal

Fourth Occurrence: student is dismissed from team
