A non-mandatory vendors conference and/or job-walk will be conducted on February 10, 2011, at 2:30 pm beginning at District Office whose address is 325 E. Huntington Drive, Monrovia, Ca. 91016. The purpose of the job walk is to visit several reference classrooms that will provide prospective vendors with the typical physical plant conditions and to discuss and clarify the terms, conditions and requirements of the project.

This is a Public Works Contract. In Accordance with Section 1720 et. Seq. of the Labor Code, the general prevailing wage rate as established by the Director of the California Department of Industrial relations will apply to this contract.
